



Carrier Logo Creation For QCP-6035 Series Handset

Overview

This document is designed to provide information for creating a custom carrier wake up logo or image for the QCP-6035 Smartphone series handsets. This document assumes the technician is familiar with photo or graphic editing software, Kyocera Wireless Phone Support Toolkit (KWPST) and QCP-6035 Smartphone.

Required Tools

1. QCP-6035 with known Service Lock Code for access.
2. The latest version of the KWPST. Currently version 3.00.59 (as of 06.05.2001)
3. Platform specific programming cable kit (TXDTA00841) or handset's cradle.
4. Photo editing software capable of custom creating 4 Bit bitmap images. (Adobe PhotoShop®, Jasc Paint Shop Pro, etc.)
5. Programming instructions for the QCP-6035 (80-B6067-2EN), available from the web site:

Caution:

It is critical that KWPST version 3.00.59 or later be used for this process. The use of an earlier version of KWPST will fatally lock the phone, even after soft/hard resets. An RMA will be required.

Procedure

Carrier "Wake Up" Logo






1. Create a bitmap image that is:
 - A. 160 pixels wide x 90 pixels high
 - B. 4 Bit Grayscale (16 shades)
 - C. Inverted (*Whites will be black on the 6035 and blacks will be white*)
2. Save the image as "CarrierLogo.bmp" (replace "CarrierLogo" with your own name of choice). Remember the file name. The file is required in step 7.



NOTE:

Do not use RLE compression if asked. This will corrupt the image for these purposes.

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Referring to the QCP-6035 programming instructions (<i>80-B6067-2EN</i>), place the QCP-6035 into service interface mode. Connect the QCP-6035 to the PC using either the supplied cradle or programming cable. Open the Service Programming client of the PST and select the connected handset.
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Select the "Smartphone Specific" tab. In the "Carrier Logo File" field, select "Browse..." and find the bitmap you created in steps 1-2 above.
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Select "Write to Phone" to load the new image into the handset. Perform a soft reset as described in the programming guide once writing to phone is complete.
